The month of July is dedicated to honoring the Most Precious Blood of Christ. June was dedicated to the Sacred Heart, and July is dedicated to honoring what flows from the Sacred Heart of Jesus, His Most Precious Blood. St. Mary Magdalen de Pazzi said every time we offer up the Blood of Christ to God, we "offer a gift of infinite worth which can be equaled by no other!" I encourage you to pray this Litany of the Precious Blood of Christ especially during this month with your families.

V. Thou hast redeemed us, O Lord, in Thy Blood.

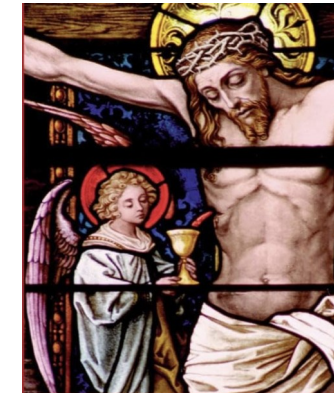
R. And made us, for our God, a kingdom.
