Merry Christmas! This year Christmas fell midweek, which means that we find ourselves with an obligation to go to Mass on Sunday, go to Mass on Christmas, go to Mass on Sunday again, and then go to Mass on New Year's again.

When I was a kid, I remember hearing someone say: 'God only asks you for one hour each week', as in, you should AT LEAST go to Mass on Sundays, it's all you have to do.

I think that is a fundamentally wrong way of living our relationship with God. He is your CREATOR and your REDEEMER. He asks for no less than all of your life, every moment of every day.

So, it's very healthy for our routine and rhythm to be upset by Holy Days of Obligation. We need to snap into action and respond to the call of God to worship Him in His greatest Mysteries.

Even more so, with Christmas and New Years, we have the choice to look at HOW we are living those days. Because if God is the center of my heart and my life, then that will be reflected in how I live the New Year. It's not going to be a drunken party if I fear offending God and enjoy pleasing Him. It's going to be prayerful, innocent – even naïve. Maybe there will be Christmas carols, giving thanks for the graces of the last year...

...And maybe, just maybe, a beautiful New Years resolution to sign up for an hour of Adoration at the MIR house...
