Thoughts by Father Benjamin Fenlon

Lent is underway, and of course – we all know it very well – we need to choose our sacrifices. I really want to encourage you to try to bite off more than you can chew. Be generous to God, don’t settle for the same old, same old!

Our Blessed Lord talks about prayer, sacrifice and almsgiving (giving to those in need), as the pathway to grow in the faith. ‘Prayer’ is not just ‘prayers’: it means TALKING to God about everything... and listening to him. ‘Sacrifice’ is not about losing comfort, but about losing the supports we need and even deserve – food, sleep, choosing physical pain. It’s about, as one saint put it, saying sorry with my body, given that I sinned with my body. Or, metaphorically, putting your money where your mouth is. And speaking of money, ‘Almsgiving’ is giving to those in need. Give of the goods you have to people you know. BUT even more so give smiles, compliments, time and attention to people also.

About a hundred years ago, back when the Christian people had a very clear idea that they needed to strive for holiness, this triad of holy works was well known and practiced. We would do well to take it up again, and what better time than this Holy season of Lent!
