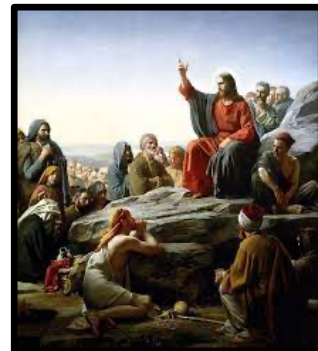

#### Did You Know?

**Full Scholarships to St. James for the Next School Year are Available! Help to Spread the News!**

Qualifications:

Pathway 1 – Students with IEP or ISP

Pathway 2 – A: Students entering Kindergarten or First Grade AND with household income no more than 200% of free and reduced income guidelines.

B: Students who have been enrolled in public school for 12 months prior AND make no more than 200% of free and reduced income guidelines.

For those who qualify, the scholarship can be renewed each year through the 12<sup>th</sup> grade!
