Qualifications:

Pathway 1 – Students with IEP or ISP

<u>Pathway 2</u> – **A**: Students entering Kindergarten or First Grade AND with household income no more than 200% of free and reduced income guidelines.

B: Students who have been enrolled in public school for 12 months prior AND make no more than 200% of free and reduced income guidelines.

For those who qualify, the scholarship can be renewed each year through the 12th grade!
