Thoughts by Father Jonathan Davis

On February 11 we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. Appearing to St. Bernadette in Lourdes, France in 1858, over the course of 15 days, Mary told St. Bernadette to pray for the conversion of sinners. On the final day she said to St. Bernadette, “I am the Immaculate Conception.” She did not know what this meant so when she told this to her parish priest, this was a sign to him that the revelations were authentic. Our Lady also told St. Bernadette to dig in the ground for water. Miraculously water came from the ground and thousands of people have been healed by this water. St. John Paul II instituted February 11 as World day of Prayer for the Sick. The Sacrament of the anointing of the sick comes to us from our Lord Jesus and we read about it in the Bible (James 5:14). The sacrament of the anointing should be given when someone becomes gravely sick, will have a serious operation, to the elderly who have become weaker, and to the dying. The effects of this sacrament are grace given to unite one’s suffering to our Lord’s sufferings and offer them for the good of the world, strength, peace, and courage to overcome difficulties. “This assistance from the Lord by the power of his Spirit is meant to lead the sick person to healing of the soul, but also of the body if such is God’s will. (Catechism, 1520)”


