

Thoughts by Father Jonathan Davis

What is sin? The Catechism of the Catholic Church says in paragraph 1849 that "Sin is an offense against reason, truth, and right conscience; it is failure in genuine love for God and neighbor caused by a perverse attachment to certain goods. It wounds the nature of man and injures human solidarity. It has been defined as "an utterance, a deed, or a desire contrary to the eternal law. (St. Augustine)"

The catechism defines virtue, the opposite of sin, as "A virtue is an habitual and firm disposition to do the good. It allows the person not only to perform good acts, but to give the best of himself. The virtuous person tends toward the good with all his sensory and spiritual powers; he pursues the good and chooses it in concrete actions."

To be cleansed of our sins, we draw near to God's mercy in the Sacrament of Confession. To grow in virtue, we must practice the virtues. Let us seek ways to grow in virtue. Let us reread these definitions of sin and virtue above, and think about each one for some time, and apply it to our lives.



Prayer to Saint Michael

Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle; be our protection against the wickedness and the snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the other evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Memorare

Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help, or sought thy intercession was left unaided.

Inspired with this confidence, I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother; to thee do I come, before thee I stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in thy mercy hear and answer me. Amen.
