Thoughts by Father, Jonathan Davis

This week we celebrate across the nation Catholic schools week. It is a time for us to give thanks to God for the gift of our Catholic schools. Through our Catholic schools our students learn to seek the True, the Good, and the Beautiful. Those words are capitalized because they reflect how the students learn that God is the essence and the ultimate source of truth, goodness, and beauty. In our Catholic schools our children learn that they are made in the image and likeness of God and their ultimate purpose in this life is to grow in their relationship with Christ while sanctifying the world around them through there lives and individual vocations until they become Saints in heaven. All of us have this same mission and goal. We are very blessed at St. James to have this school that serves as a means for our children to encounter God through the subjects they study. It is a joy for me to visit the classrooms and see the kids happy to be there. In each of our classrooms our great teachers intertwine faith through all the subjects.
