

Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ has chosen to remain with us. He says, "And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the world." In every church our Lord remains present for us in the tabernacle in the Holy Eucharist. I would like to invite everyone to make some time each week to come to adore Jesus in Eucharistic Adoration. At St. James we have adoration on Mondays from 8:30am-7pm. On Tuesday's at St. Patrick we have adoration from 12pm-7pm and on Sundays from 7pm-8pm.
