Ephesians 2:13-18; Mark 6:30-34

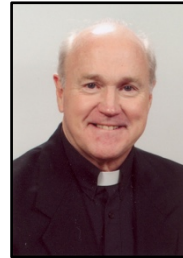
“He said to them, “Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while.” MARK 6:31
