Thoughts by Father Jonathan Davis

The month of the Precious Blood. The month of July is dedicated to honoring the Most Precious Blood of Christ. June was dedicated to the Sacred Heart, and July is dedicated to honoring what comes from the Sacred Heart of Jesus, His Most Precious Blood. The Blood of Christ is the price our Lord paid to save us. When the Sacred Heart of Christ was pierced with a lance, Blood and water came forth, giving power to the Sacraments of the Church. The Most Precious Blood of Christ is our protection from evil. We remember how the Jewish people were spared God's wrath when they painted the blood of a lamb on their doorposts and the avenging angel passed over their homes without striking down their first born sons. When we receive Holy Communion and absolution from our sins in confession, our hearts and souls are painted with the Most Precious Blood of Christ. We can and should offer the Most Precious of Christ in reparation for our sins and the sins of the entire world. St. Mary Magdalen de Pazzi said every time we offer up the Blood of Christ to God, we “offer a gift of infinite worth which can be equaled by no other!” Below is the Litany of the Most Precious Blood of Jesus. I encourage all of you and your families to frequently pray this litany together especially during the month of July.

Christ, have mercy on us.

God, the Father of Heaven, *have mercy on us.*
God the Son, Redeemer of the world, *have mercy on us.*

Blood of Christ, flowing forth in the Crowning with Thorns,
Blood of Christ, poured out on the Cross,
