Thoughts by Father Jonathan Davis

On June 29, we celebrate the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. St. Peter was named by Jesus to be the rock on which he built our Church. He said to him, “You are Peter and, on this rock, I will build my church and the Gates of Hell shall not prevail against it.” The word and name Peter comes from the Latin word *pietra* which means rock. St. Peter’s Basilica in Rome is built above the bones of St. Peter. It is true that the Gates of Hell shall never prevail against the Church. In the first reading, we hear how St. Peter was imprisoned and guarded by four squadrons of guards and was bound by double chains. In the middle of the night, an angel came and released him and guided him away from the prison. St. Peter, who denied that he knew Christ three times, was asked by Jesus Christ to feed his sheep three times. This threefold profession of his love solidified his desire to lay down his life for Christ. Truly, St. Peter did offer his blood for the faith. St. Paul used to be a persecutor of the Church who consented to the killing of Saint Stephen, the first martyr. By a miraculous conversion, St. Paul became a true Apostle of our Lord. The majority of the New Testament is written by Saint Paul. In a similar way St. Paul was also released from prison. This is proof to the words of Jesus Christ the Gates of Hell will never prevail against the Church. Those who go against the teachings of the Church will fail because the Rock is Jesus Christ and He is immovable. Directly beneath the altar in St. Peter’s Basilica in Rome, archaeologists have found the bones of the apostle, Peter. Literally on the rock of Peter, the Church has been built. It will never be destroyed. Jesus Christ founded One Church. In The Creed, we profess that we believe in one, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church. These are the four characteristics of the Church. The Church is one. Jesus founded one Church. The Church is Holy because it is founded by Jesus Christ. The Church is Apostolic because the bishops today are the successors to the apostles. The Church is Catholic because Jesus instituted the Church for the entire world. The word Catholic means universal. Let us on this day give thanks to God for the gift of our faith. Let us give thanks to God and offer our tears of joy for being part of the Church.
