Happy Mother's Day to all Mothers! On this weekend when we honor all mothers, we give thanks to God for them, and we thank them for giving us life and for the love they have shown us. Let us also pray for the souls of our deceased mothers and grandmothers. I remember my own mother with great love, who passed away in August of 2020. She was an amazing mom, and I am so grateful to God for the gift of my mom. I know she continues to pray for me. Nothing is like a mother's love and so Jesus wanted to give us his mother too. Before he died on the Cross he said to St. John, who represented all of mankind, "Son, behold your mother," and to Mary He said, "Woman, behold your son." The gift of his mother is the last gift that Jesus gave to the world before he died. Mary is our spiritual mother. Through her we have received the Life and Light of the world, our Savior Jesus Christ. May is the month of Mary and on May 13th we honor our Lady of Fatima which was the date of the first apparition of Mary to the three shepherd children Lucia, Jacinta, and Francesco in 1917. From that day she appeared on the 13th of every month until on October 13th, when the Miracle of the sun took place when the sun danced before 70,000 people at Fatima, Portugal. The primary message of Mary at Fatima is that we need to pray and make sacrifices for the conversion of sinners. The Rosary is the greatest Marian prayer that we have. St. Padre Pio who had the stigmata, the five wounds of Christ, for 50 years said, "Go to the Madonna. Love her! Always say the Rosary. Say it well. Say it as often as you can! Be souls of prayer. Never tire of praying, it is what is essential. Prayer shakes the Heart of God. It obtains necessary graces!" "Love the Madonna and pray the Rosary, for her Rosary is the weapon against the evils of the world today. All graces given by God pass through the Blessed Mother." Also Bl. Pope Pius IX said "Give me an army saying the Rosary and I will conquer the world." During this month of Mary let us have an increased devotion to Mary and the Holy Rosary. Let us pray it in our homes, and with our families. Remember the famous quote "The family that prays together, stays together." Happy Mother's Day to all Mothers!
