Congratulations to our parishioners and students who were recently Confirmed and to those who received First Holy Communion. And a special thank you to Melissa Cox for the beautiful pictures!

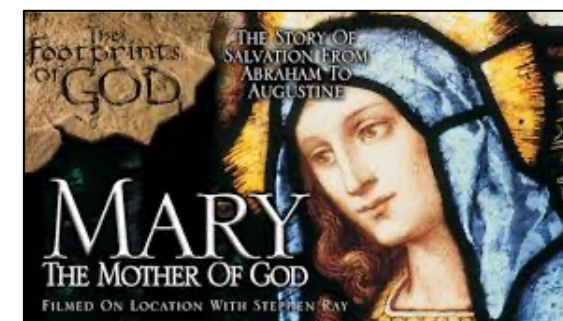
