The first three paragraphs of the Catechism of the Catholic Church read, “God, infinitely perfect and blessed in Himself, in a plan of sheer goodness freely created man, to make him share in his own blessed life. For this reason, at every time and in every place, God draws close to man. He calls man to seek Him, to know him, to love Him with all his strength. He calls together all men, scattered and divided by sin, into the unity of His family, the Church.” “So that this call should resound throughout the world, Christ sent forth the apostles he had chosen, commissioning them to proclaim the gospel: “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age”; “All Christ’s faithful are called to hand it on from generation to generation, by professing the faith, by living it in fraternal sharing, and by celebrating it in liturgy and prayer.

It is a historical fact that the first bishops of the Church ordained by Christ were the Apostles. They ordained other Bishops after them who ordained others Bishops and priests.
